11 Amazing Indoor Play Spaces in NYC

Some things are inevitable come winter. (Salt-covered stroller wheels and slush pools at every street corner, for starters.) But other things—like the kids going a little stir-crazy—are totally avoidable. The five boroughs are teeming with well-stocked (and well-heated) indoor play spaces. Flip through this album for 11 of our favorites.



For an NYC playscape: Apple Seeds

Need a sure-fire way to entertain the under five set? Head straight to Apple Seeds, which has locations in Gramercy and the Upper West Side. Membership isn't cheap, but you get a lot of bang for your buck: unlimited access to the bright and airy play spaces *and* guest passes which make for the easiest play date ever. Each location is stocked with sensory-rich features custom-made for the curious and energetic. You'll find a well-padded play area where babies can practice cruising; a tricked-out gym with a basketball net and soft equipment for climbing and belly flopping; a build-your-own-adventure LEGO table, and a miniature cityscape where kids can race through an apartment building, run a deli and (because this is New York) drive a cab.
